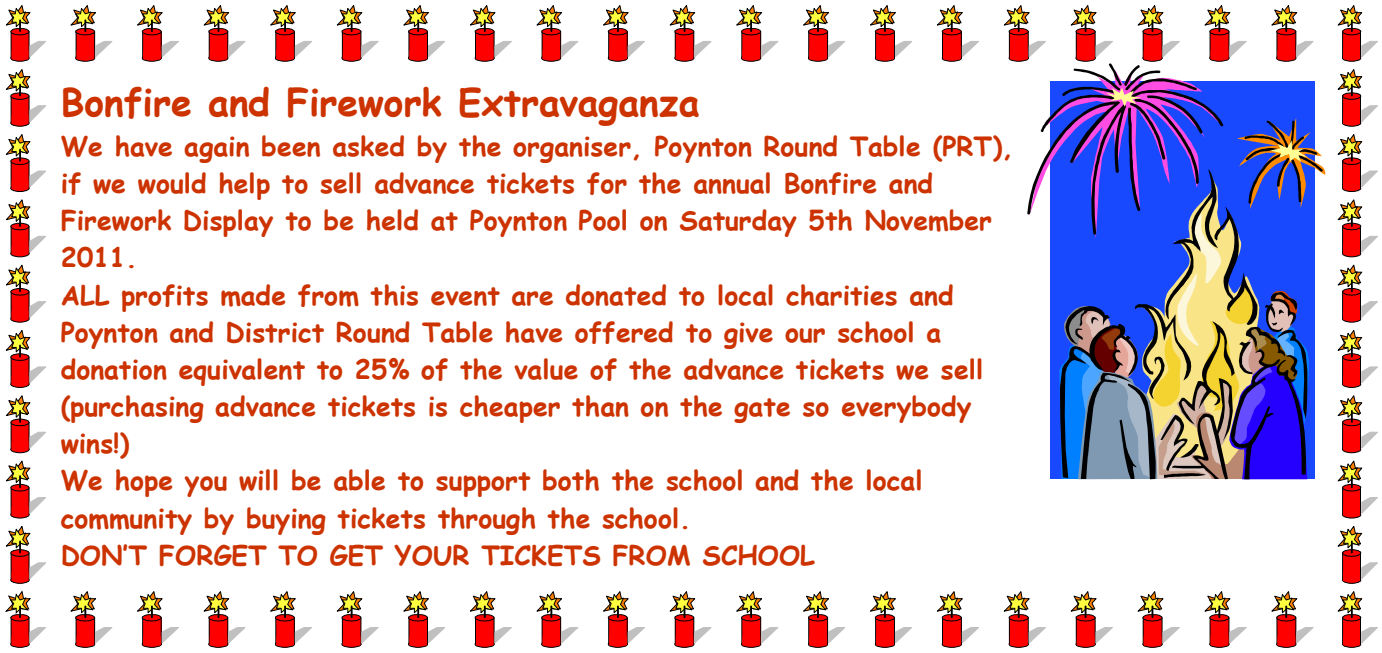
BIKEABILITY— REMINDER
