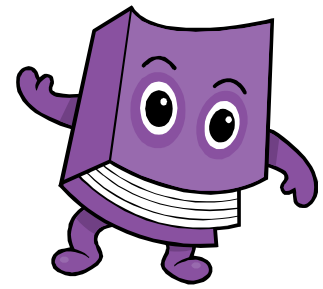

Visitors

This week saw a variety of visitors to school. Starting on Tuesday with a visit from Poynton Library by Wendy Craddock. All Reception children have received a free book and Wendy came to read from the books and help promote the Library service. The class were given information on what to expect from the library and how to become a member.



Tuesday also saw the first visit of the week from PCSO's Chris Howard and Mandy Simpson. They were here to speak with all of our KS2 children about the effects that Bullying can have upon the victims and what they can do if they themselves are the victim of bullying, and more importantly who they can talk to.

Wednesday saw a return visit by Chris Howard, with Rob Massey and Chris Luke. They were here to talk to our Reception/Year 1 class about road safety after a very close near miss involving one of our children and a vehicle. The children were taken out of the school grounds and shown how to cross a road safely and responsibly.



On Thursday and Friday we were joined by two members from Cyclist Training Ltd who were here to give our Year 5/6 class a two day training course on how to ride their bikes responsibly.

During the Level 2 Bikeability training they are able to get out on the roads! Level 2 gives the children a real cycling experience so that they are able to deal with traffic on short journeys such as cycling to schools.



Following their training the children should be able to do the following:

- Start and finish a journey by road, including passing parked or slower moving vehicles
- Be aware of everything around you and signal your intentions to other road users when someone needs to know what you're doing
- Position yourself properly on the road and pass side roads
- Use junctions including turning left and right into major and minor roads
- Decide whether a cycle lane will help with your journey
- Use the Highway Code, particularly when it comes to understanding road signs
