This is an ideal opportunity for you to come and meet with our kitchen staff, Jackie and Sharon.

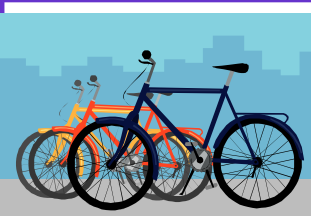
